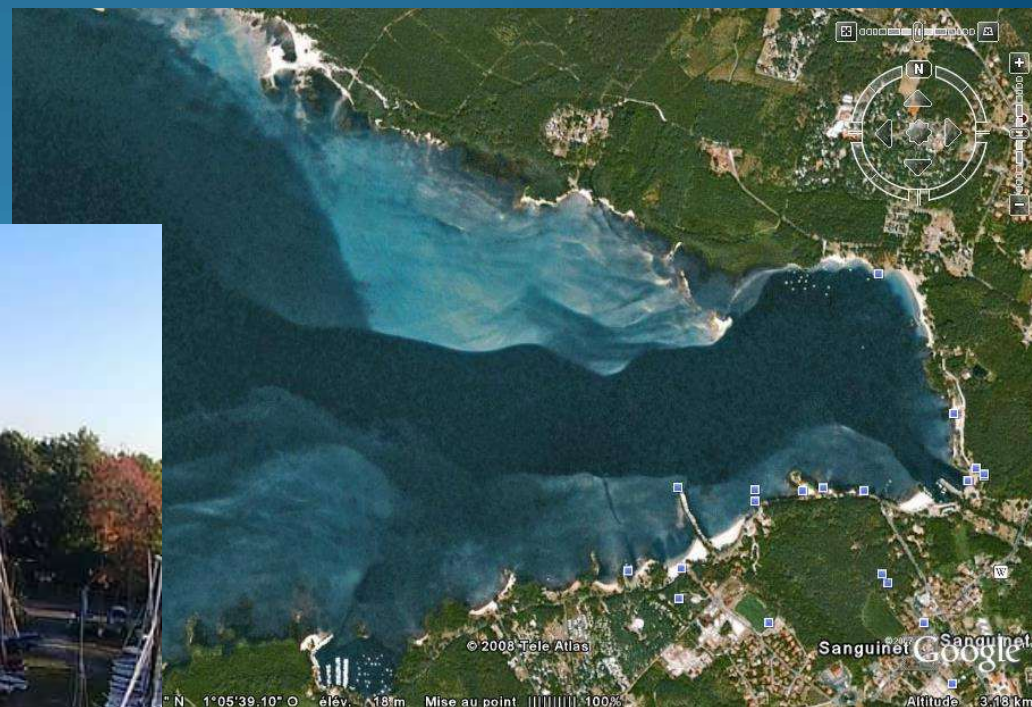

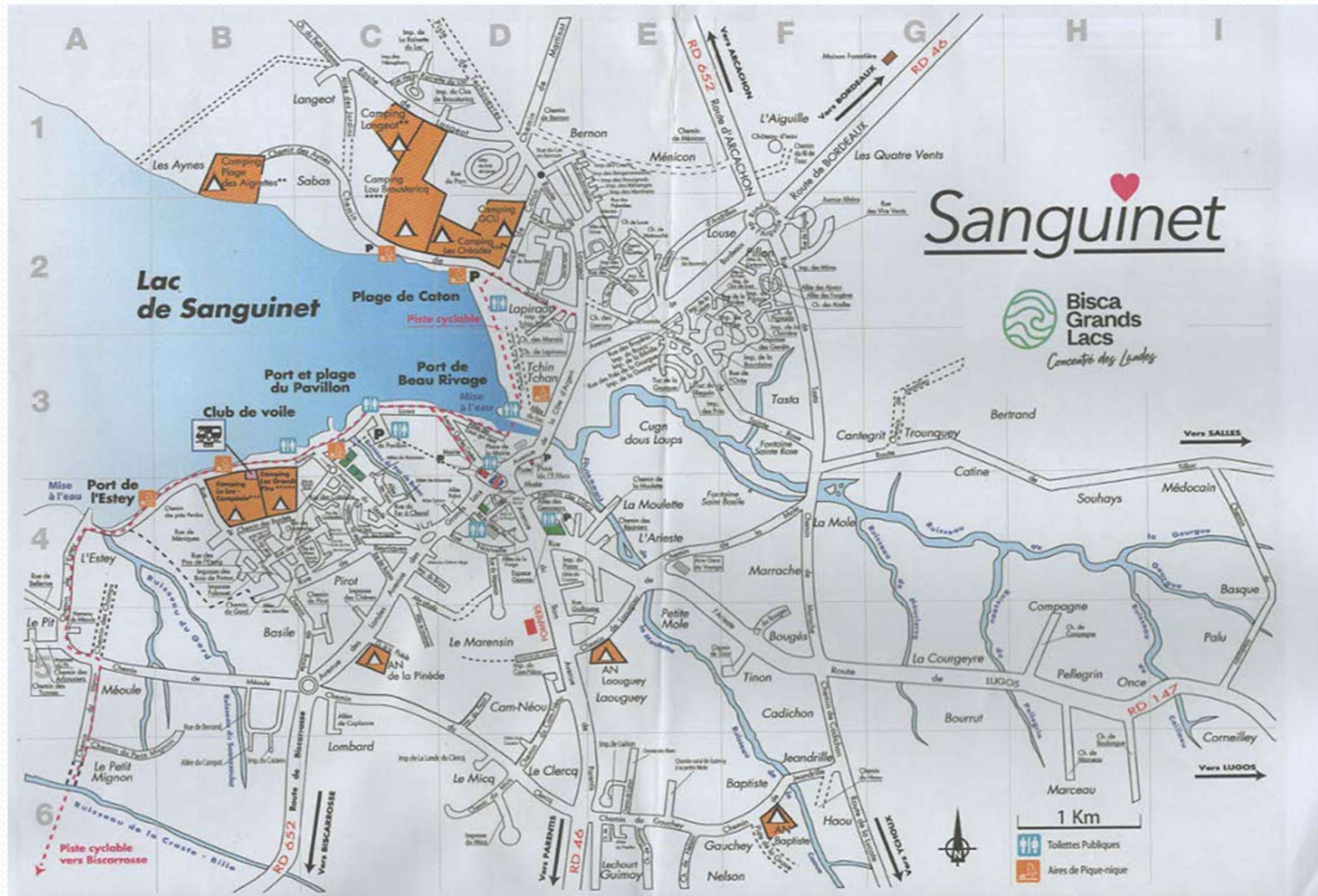

The Town





The place

- Near Bordeaux, the Arcachon basin, and Biscarrosse, in the heart of the Landes forest, Lake Sanguinet (5,608 hectares) is the 2nd largest freshwater lake in France, renowned as one of the best inland bodies of water in Europe for the quality of its water.
- Favored by thermal breezes of force 3 to 5 Beaufort from the west / northwest, this lake offers great safety for water sports (sailing, wing foiling, windsurfing, canoeing, kayaking, etc.).
- It is a prime location for hosting major national and international sailing competitions.
- Sailors and their companions can happily discover the Aquitaine Coast and the Great Lakes region.
- The town of Sanguinet, a tourist resort located on the eastern shore of the lake, has for many years been developing a sports-oriented tourism policy while preserving its environment and history.
- The underwater discovery of several lake dwellings has given the lake widespread archaeological renown in its protohistoric period.



Club de Voile of Sanguinet

- CVS, founded in 1961, is one of the largest clubs in the South Aquitaine region.
- It has gained its reputation and extensive experience over the years by organizing major events: regional and national championships, and especially two highly successful Class A World Championships in 1993 and 2005.
- Throughout the year, it brings together some 330 members. The majority sail on catamarans, but in recent years, some racers have switched to modern, lightweight, adaptable, and above all very fast and spectacular monohull classes: the Skiff classes.
- Its sailing school, staffed by state-certified sports instructors and federal instructors, welcomes over 900 trainees each year. It has enabled five young sailors to reach the highest national and international levels.

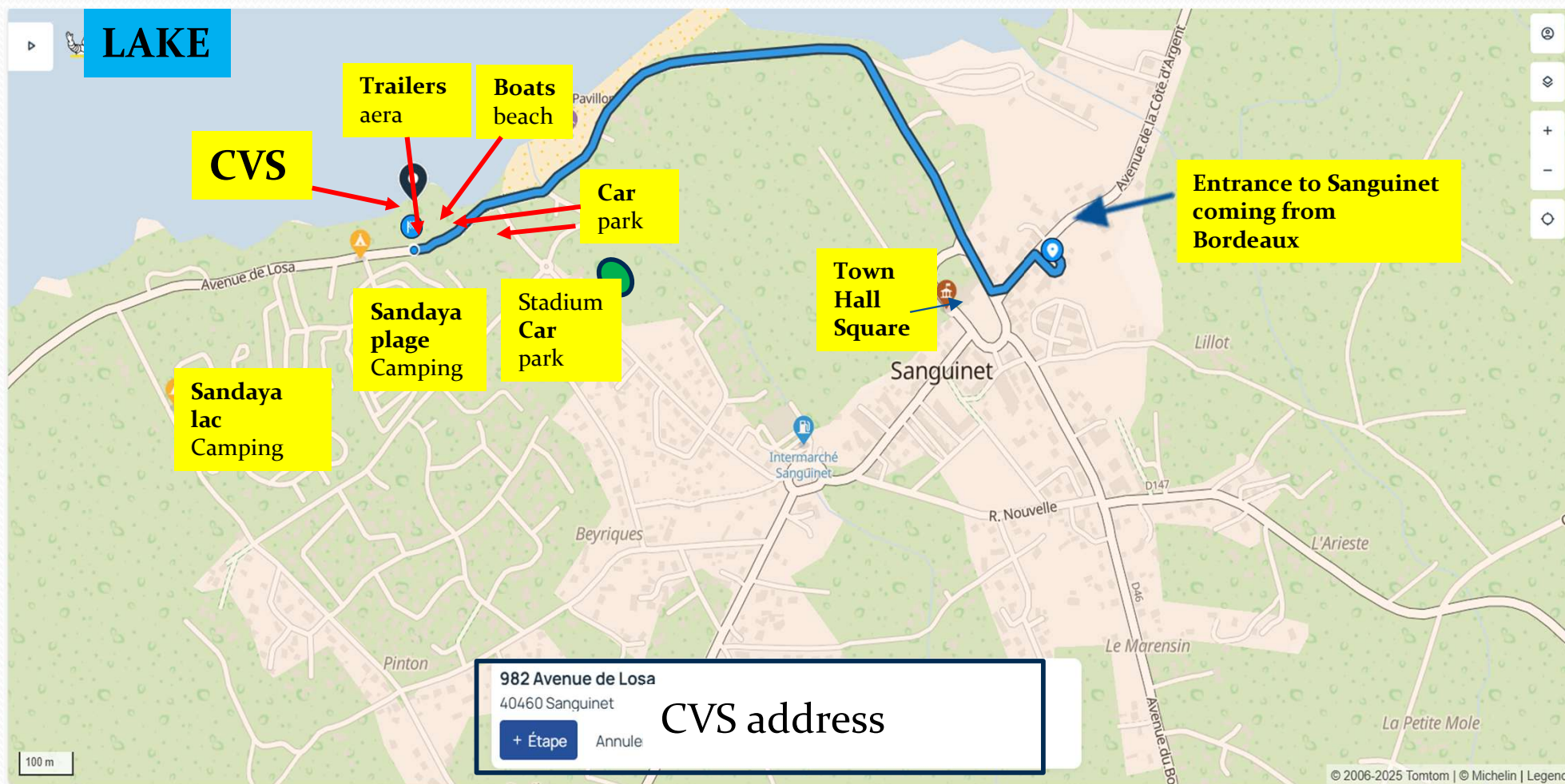
